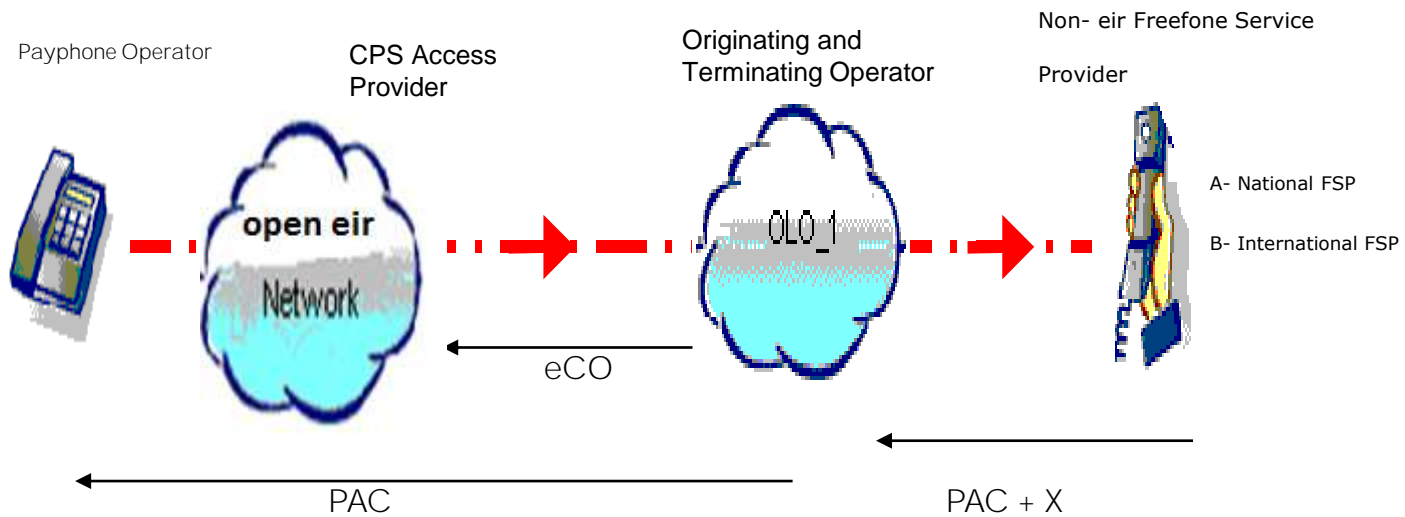
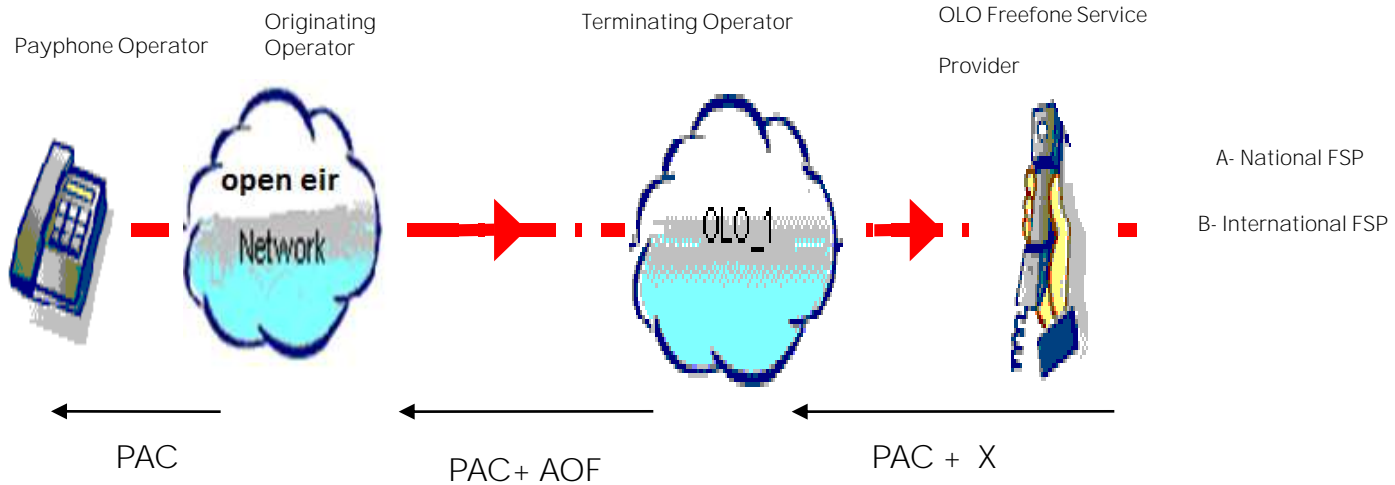


Scenario 1 - Payphone Operator is CPS
- Freefone Service Provider is supported by the same OLO

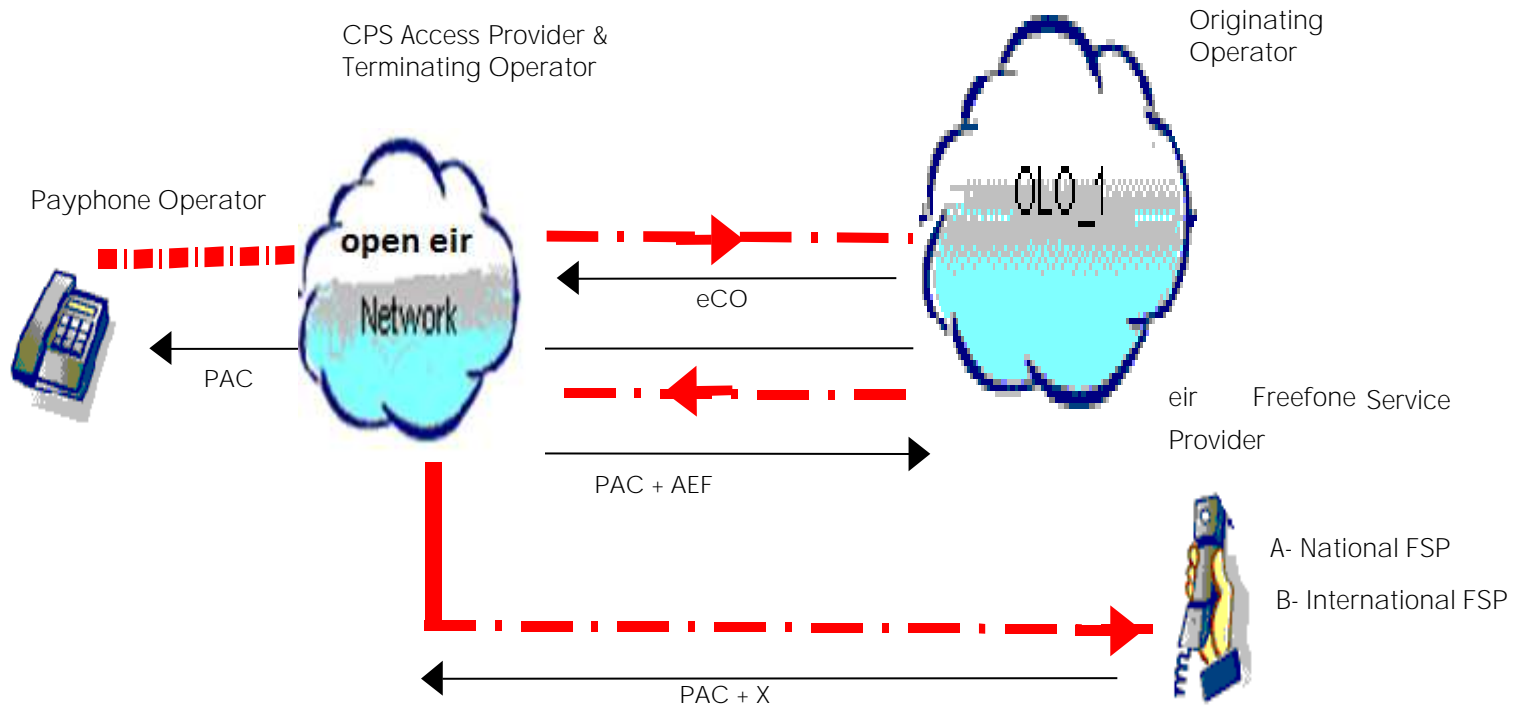


Scenario 2 - Payphone operator is directly connected to open eir
- Freefone Service Provider is OLO supported



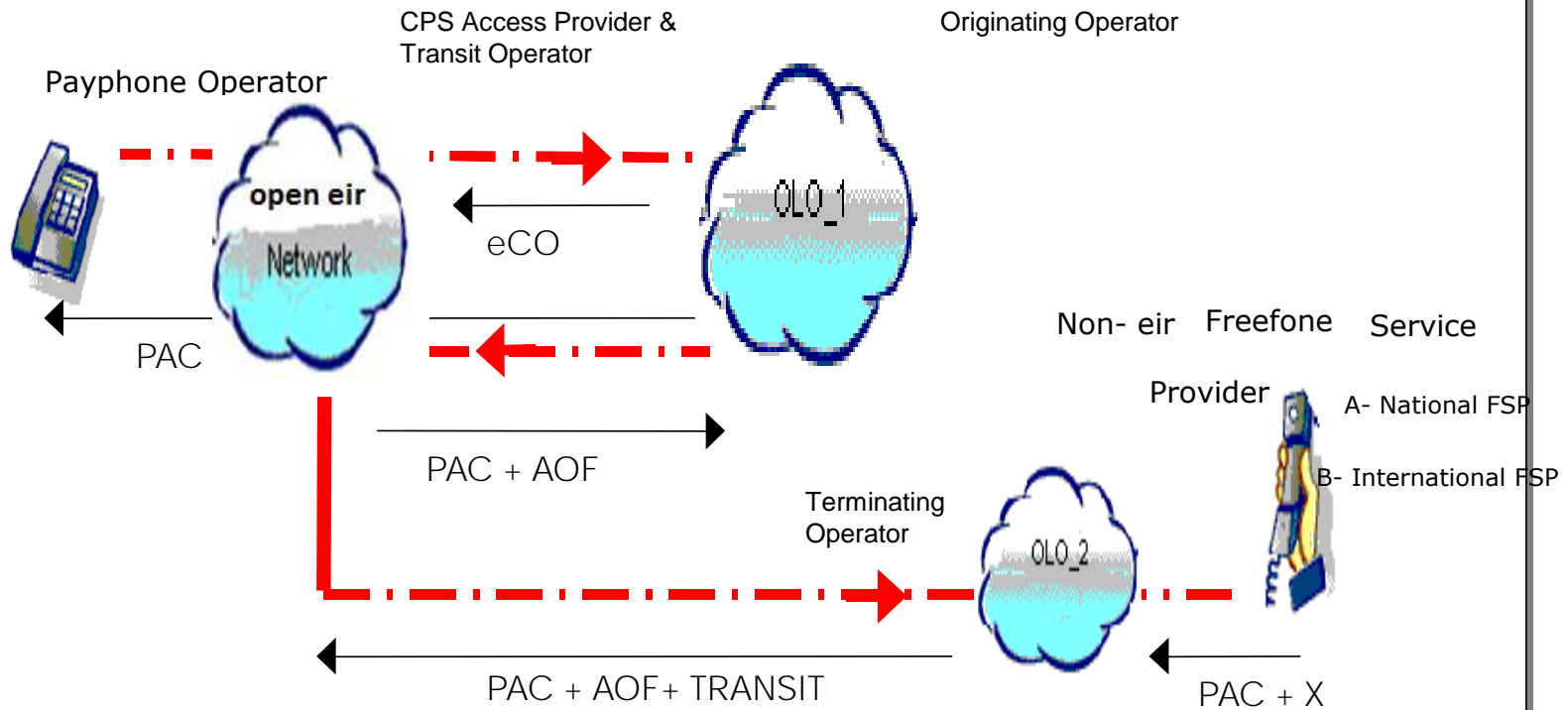
Scenario 3 - Payphone operator is CPS

— - Freefone Service Provider is open eir supported

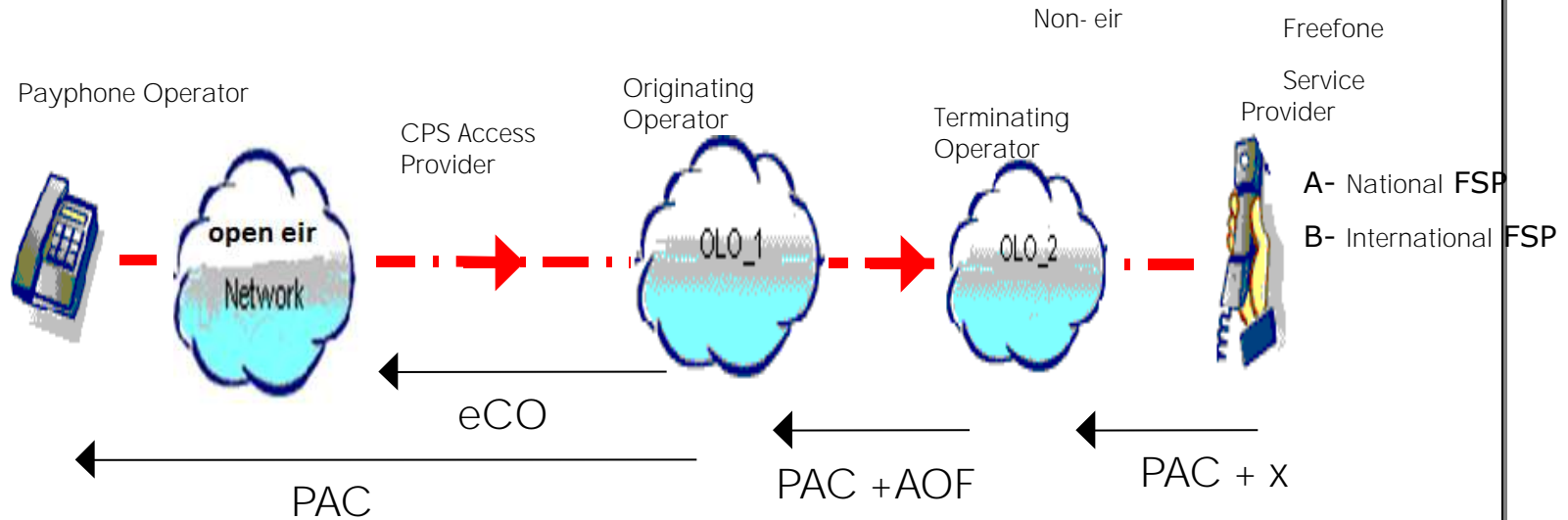


Scenario 4 - Payphone operator is CPS

— Freefone Service Provider is supported by a 2nd OLO

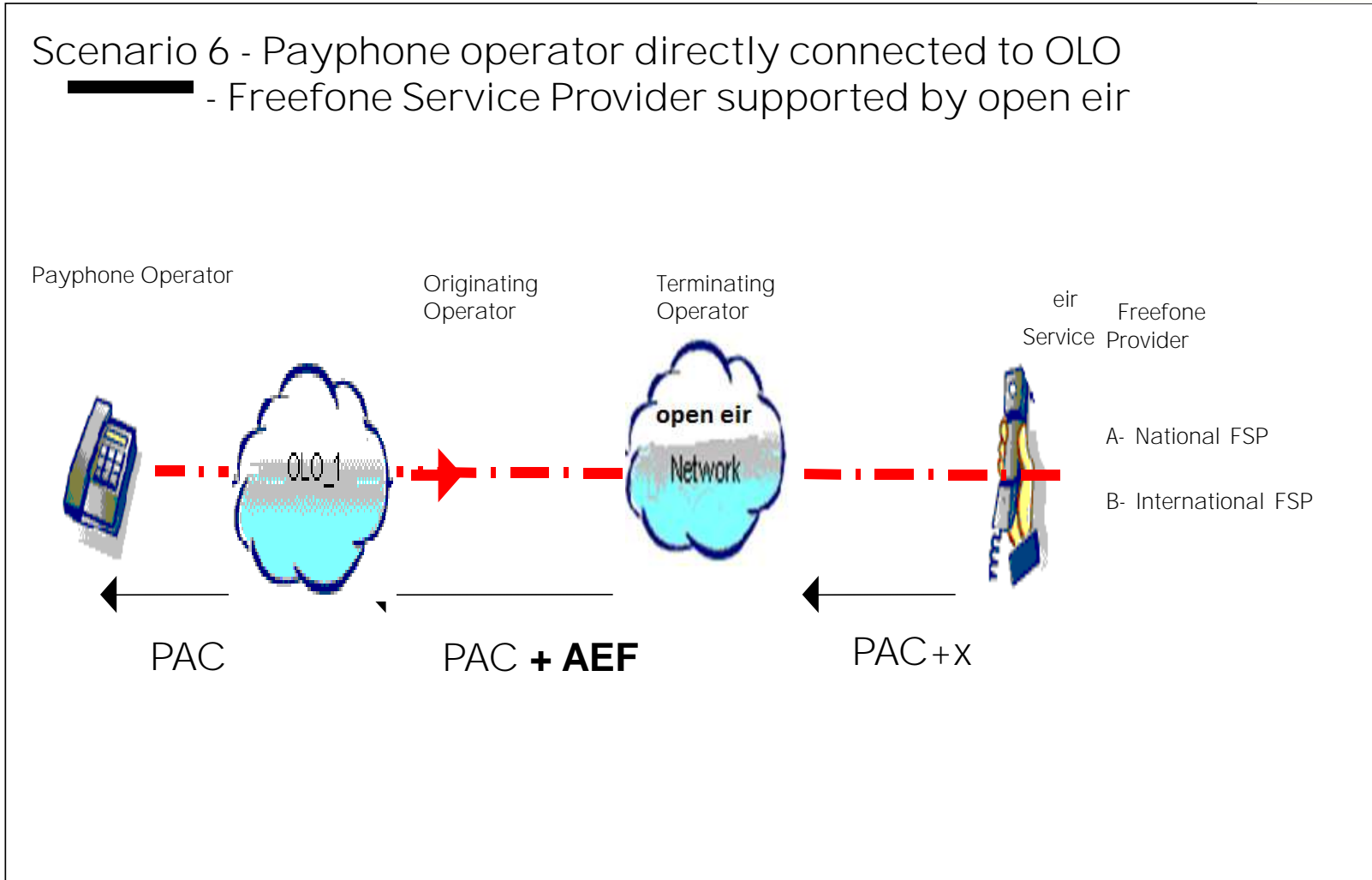


Scenario 5 - Payphone operator is CPS
